- ✓ The very fact that during this year 44% girl students studying in the college reveals that the academic programmes offered by our institution have attracted the women community by catering their needs.

- ✓ As part of the Quality Concern, concrete steps have been taken in establishing an Internal Quality Assurance Cell in the campus. The external members of IQAC were replaced with more dynamic personalities so that they play a proactive role in the cell
- ✓ The tutoring system has been implemented for the last few years. In this system every class has a tutor, a senior staff-member of the department, who would keep track and monitor the academic progress made by the students of that particular class

Research activities

Ever since the inception of the research centre in Microbiology, Tamil, Computer Science, Commerce, Biochemistry, Research Scholars and faculty members in Microbiology has catered the younger generation on the importance of the issue. A multidisciplinary approach in research is given by merging biological sciences such as Biochemistry, Microbiology and Biotechnology. Recent technological up gradation has been taught and implemented in the field of Life Sciences and projects are being carried out in the field of Nanotechnology and Genomics. The field of research in life sciences area caters the needs of the society at all levels.
