27. Technology upgradation:

Microprocessor kit for the college has been purchased in the current academic year worth Rs. 2,66,220 for the UG and PG students of the department of Computer Science and Department of Computer Application. Computer accessories worth Rs. 70,000 were purchased for various departments of the college to meet the demand of the increase in the technology. Office administration is fully computerized and the campus is fully connected with intranet and internet.

28. Computer and Internet access and training to teachers and students:

One-day training programme on Information Communication Technology (ICT) usage and Office Automation has been conducted to teaching and nonteaching staff members. Internet access is provided to all students through computer laboratories at their allotted time period.

29. Financial aid to students:

Apart from the Government Scholarships the Management has distributed towards scholarships for sports persons and economically poor counting 12 students this year.
