the issue. A multidisciplinary approach in research is given by merging biological sciences such as Biochemistry, Microbiology and Biotechnology. Recent technological up gradation has been taught and implemented in the field of Life Sciences and projects are being carried out in the field of Nanotechnology and Genomics. The field of research in life sciences area caters the needs of the society at all levels.
